# **Associate Home Inspector Licensure Application Instructions and requirements**

#### **Item 1**. A complete application package shall consist of the following items:

- a. A completed *Associate Home Inspector Licensure Application* with a 2x2 passport quality photo.
- b. Application fee of \$225 payable by check or money order to the Commonwealth of MA.
- c. Complete Supervisor form(s) from licensed Home Inspectors in good standing.
- d. A total of 25 documented non-mock Home inspections listed on supervisory form.
- e. Documentation of passing the Board approved examination (National Home Inspector exam)
- f. Documentation of successful completion of 75 hours of Educational Training Credits. Formal coursework must include not less than:
  - (a) 6 hours dedicated to the inspection of roofing,
  - (b) 6 hours dedicated to the inspection of exterior cladding system(s).
  - (c) 6 hours dedicated to the inspection of masonry system(s).
  - (d) 9 hours dedicated to the inspection of structural system(s).
  - (e) 9 hours dedicated to the inspection of electrical system(s).
  - (f) 9 hours dedicated to the inspection of plumbing system(s).
  - (g) 9 hours dedicated to the inspection of heating and air conditioning systems.
  - (h) 6 hours shall be dedicated to the 266 CMR regulations including the standards of practice.
  - (i) 6 hours dedicated to Report writing.
  - (i) 3 hours dedicated to professional ethics.
  - (k) 3 hours dedicated to contract law.
  - (I) 3 hours independently selected additional open Training Credits.
- g. Proof of a certificate of errors and omissions insurance policy, which shall be in a minimum amount of \$250,000 in the aggregate.

## **Item 2**. Educational Training Credit in an Education Training Credit Program must be documented according to the following and contain:

- (a) The title of the program or course.
- (b) The number of hours spent in the program or course.
- (c) The name of the Board recognized entity or the academic institution that sponsored the program or course.
- (d) The dates and location that the programs, courses, workshops, or seminars were given.

**Item 3**. The Board shall promptly notify an applicant in writing, whether his/her application has been approved. If the Board approves the application, the Board shall issue to the applicant an Associate Home Inspector License. The computation of the one year period referred to in M.G.L. c. 112, § 222(13) (c)3. shall begin upon issuance of the Associate Home Inspector license.
