National Guard plates can only be registered by active members of the National Guard or by members who have retired after 20 or more years of service. The Registration fee is \$60 and the Special Plate fee is \$40.

A. Instructions and Requirements

1. Complete Applicant Info section.
2. Send or bring to Massachusetts National Guard Headquarters. The address is:

3. Visit an RMV Service Center or mail this completed application, a completed Registration and Title Application (RTA) including insurance company stamp, and a check or money order for \$100 (payable to MassDOT) to the address at the top of the form. The new plates will be mailed in 7-10 days.
