A. Requirements and Instructions

IF YOU RECEIVE THE MEDAL OF LIBERTY, YOU ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE MEDAL OF LIBERTY PLATE FREE OF CHARGE.

A Medal of Liberty Plate can be issued to the approved Next of Kin (NOK) of service men and women from Massachusetts who were killed in action or died in service while in a designated combat area in the line of duty or who died as a result of wounds received in action.

The approved NOK recipient of the Medal of Liberty can register one private passenger motor vehicle owned and principally used by him/her. Medal of Liberty Plates are not available for motorcycles.

Instructions:

1. Complete this form and mail it to the above address, along with the following documentation (either an original or a certified copy) as proof of eligibility. A photocopy will be retained by the RMV as part of the application.
 - An approved **Recommendation for the Massachusetts Medal of Liberty** form (TAGMA form 3367) certified by the Office of the Adjutant General. See sample: <https://www.mass.gov/doc/klv-sample-recommendation-for-medal-of-liberty/download>
2. You must also provide a completed Registration and Title Application (stamped by your insurance company). If you qualify, you will then be issued your plates.
