## A. Requirements and Instructions

Complete this application if you qualify, as a surviving spouse, for Veterans' Plates under Chapter 407 of the Acts of 2008. There is an initial \$100 fee for passenger plates. The renewal fee is \$100.

There is an initial \$40 fee for motorcycle plates. The renewal fee is \$40.

There is a \$20 fee to swap a Flag Plate for a Branch of Service Decal Plate, or a Branch of Service Decal Plate for a Flag Plate.

### Instructions:

Complete and sign this application.

Visit any full service RMV Service Center with:

- Complete application
- Payment
- Copy of your current vehicle registration
- Copy of spouse's Death Certificate
- Affidavit of Surviving Spouse
- Complete Registration and Title Application (RTA) including insurance company stamp
- One of the following:
  - A photocopy of your "DD-214," (long form only) that indicates "Honorable" in the Character of Service box
  - A photocopy of a DD-215 amending your DD-214 granting your award that indicates an honorable discharge
  - A photocopy of an Honorable Discharge Form (used during WWII and Korea)
