License exam results appeal of Juan Campos Gonzalez-Chairman Daniel Kilburn introduced himself and members of the board. Chairman Kilburn stated that he reviewed the exam and appeal. He asked the appellant what was the basis of the appeal? The appellant stated that he has taken the exam three times and failed each time. He stated that he felt there was more than one answer to the exam questions. Chairman Kilburn stated that the exam questions are reviewed periodically and there is only one correct answer to each question. Chairman Kilburn asked the appellant if he took a class to prepare for the exam. He stated that he did not, that his employer provides them with study materials. Chairman Kilburn asked the appellant if they had a 1B crane. He stated that there is a truck with a small crane. Inspector Dougherty asked if the appellant could ask other employees for help with studying for the exam. He said that he does ask them questions. Chairman Kilburn asked the other members of the board if they had any questions, and they did not. He asked the appellant if he had anything to add and the appellant indicated that he did not. Chairman Kilburn stated that no decision would be announced during the hearing and concluded the hearing. After the public hearing concluded, the Board deliberated in quasi-judicial session and unanimously denied the appeal.
