

MINUTES

April 25, 2022

A (Hybrid Zoom) Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on April 25, 2022. In participation was: Superintendent Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, Secretary Arthur Neill, and Commissioners Emily Beebe and Jim Quirk.

Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to approve the minutes of March 21, 2022. Motion 2nd by Commissioner Beebe. The Board voted unanimously by way of roll call to approve minutes with Commissioner Quirk abstaining due to his absence from that meeting.

Superintendent Sakolsky informed the Board that the SRB meeting to certify budgets would be held May 16th. At this time, we have received no comments from our member communities on our proposed FY23 budget.

Superintendent Sakolsky also informed the Board that a new hire started today. The Project still has 3 open positions that will be posted and filled after treating season.

Superintendent Sakolsky confirmed that employee wage adjustments have been completed and retro was included.

Cape Cod National Seashore has finally issued a permit for larviciding. Assistant Superintendent Morris and Entomologist Paolino have found larvae in quantities that has exceeded thresholds required for treatment.

Lastly, the Board discussed the status of the Mosquito Control for the 21st Century Task Force who have finalized their recommendations for legislation.

The next meeting was scheduled for May 23, 2022 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Commissioner Quirk moved to adjourn, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
