

MINUTES

April 5, 2024

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on April 5, 2024. In participation was: Supt. Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Asst. Supt. Bart Morris, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, Secretary Arthur Neill, and Commissioners James Quirk and Emily Beebe.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:

Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is meeting remotely pursuant to legislative authorization extending the remote meeting provisions of the Open Meeting Law through 3/31/25, as signed into law by Governor Healey on March 29, 2023.

Supt. Sakolsky informed that no bids were received for the Request for Proposal (RFP). Division of Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) representative Peter Woodford informed Supt. Sakolsky that he would be meeting with DCAMM legal counsel on Monday to discuss the issuance of a special invitation for proposal and posting waiver due to the emergency situation.

The Board discussed expanding the search parameters by including the town of Barnstable and giving a greater square footage range.

Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to expand RFP search to include the Town of Barnstable, and to adjust the size requirements to 1400-2000sq ft with the required +/-10% assumed. Commissioner Quirk 2nd the motion and it was approved unanimously by way of roll call.

In the event we are unable to find space by the time the lease ends, there is an option for a month-to-month authorization to pay rent, as long as the landlord approves.

The next meeting was scheduled for Monday April 29, 2024 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Collins motioned to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Commissioner Quirk and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
