


Important Updates


- → Accumulated precipitation departures are trending closer to normal.
- → Amidst an active pattern, guidance indicating a weather system this weekend to bring additional precipitation and corresponding river rises.





Precipitation Departures






• Improved precipitation departures in the near term, but still slight below normal for parts of MA in past 30 days








- Essentially snow free across MA
- Headwaters of Connecticut and Merrimack still have snow; however, modeled snow depth is generally a bit less than normal











Future Precipitation Forecast & Probabilities








Latest River Forecasts


NAEFS - 10 Day Accumulated Precipitation Probabilities





Based on North American Ensemble Forecast System Model Simulations Used to Estimate the Range of Possible River Levels






