The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), pursuant to M.G.L. c. 21A, §§ 2 and 8, M.G.L. c. 111, §§ 2C, and 142A through 142D, is proposing to amend 310 CMR 7.02(14) *Cumulative Impact Analysis* to extend the deadline for MassDEP to complete a program review from December 31, 2025, to December 31, 2027 to allow MassDEP, permit applicants, and environmental justice populations to gain experience implementing the CIA program before conducting a program review. In accordance with M.G.L. c. 30A, MassDEP will hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments online and via telephone:
