# MassDOT Highway Division Construction Contract: 128297 ARLINGTON CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW DISTRICT FOUR ADMINISTRATION BUILDING ON APPLETON STREET

February 26, 2025



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Staffing resources is a cross-cutting theme of the Beyond Mobility Long Range Transportation Plan. Within this theme, the plan notes challenges in staff attraction and retention. Modern workplace facilities helps MassDOT foster an environment where employees want to work.

The building is designed to meet or exceed Executive Order No. 594 "Leading By Example: Decarbonizing and Minimizing Environmental Impacts of State Government".



# **Project Needs**

The project consists of constructing a new District 4 Administration office building to replace the existing 24,500 sf. building constructed in 1956. The new building will be approximately 47,500 sq ft., comprising 3-stories with a partial basement and mechanical penthouse.

A space program study revealed that more space is required to serve the District's current and future needs.

A building study explored renovation vs. new construction options and concluded that new construction was favored due to the necessary expansion in building size for staff needs and the extent of required upgrades to renovate the existing building to meet current building and energy codes and to address seismic/structural needs, accessibility, fire suppression, and energy/HVAC system deficiencies.

Furthermore, renovation would require relocating staff to an offsite facility during construction.

For these reasons, a new building is presented as a greater value and better option.

# " Leading by Example "

The proposed office building has a compact plan consisting of offices and meeting spaces on all three floors and a materials lab on the first floor.

The building is designed to meet or exceed Executive Order No. 594 "Leading By Example: Decarbonizing and Minimizing Environmental Impacts of State Government". This includes Passive House Certification and Net Zero.

The building and on-site photovoltaic systems are designed to generate as much energy as the building consumes in a typical year.

# **Construction Management Approach**

Construction will require the phased demolition of the existing concrete-framed building. The existing cell tower will remain intact and operational throughout construction.

**Phase 1** involves demolition of a garage and construction of the new building, during which the existing 2-story and 1-story wings will remain operational. On completion, District 4 personnel will move into the new building.

**Phase 2** involves demolition of the remaining building and sitework, including landscape and construction of the PV shade structures over parking.

Construction will take approximately thirty-three (33) months to complete.









# **Questions from Capital Programs Committee**

### Q1. This is vertical construction and generally state building projects fall into Designer Selection Board. Is MassDOT exempt from that process?

MassDOT oversees construction of buildings which are owned by the agency

### Q2. Can you speak to accessibility aspects of the project?

The new building will be fully accessible. The current facility features a second floor that is only accessible by stairs.

### Q3. Is this building LEED certified and if so what level?

The building design has been advanced to achieve Passive House Certification en lieu of LEED certification, a strategy endorsed by the Leading By Example Team at MA Department of Energy Resources.

PURPOSE:							

The purpose of this Staff Summary is to request that the Board of Directors authorize and approve the Secretary/CEO, or her designee, to execute MassDOT Contract No. 128297 titled, ARLINGTON- CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW DISTRICT FOUR ADMINISTRATION BUILDING ON APPLETON STREET for [contract purpose], with Cranshaw Construction of New England LP, for \$37,613,024.00 for a total duration, not to exceed 1002 days from Notice to Proceed (NTP).

#### TOTAL PROGRAM BUDGET:

The project has a total program budget of \$43,405,337.60, which includes the following:

#### DISCUSSION:

- The project consists of constructing a new District 4 Administration office building to replace the existing office building constructed in 1956. The new building will be approximately 47,500 sq ft., comprising 3-stories with a partial basement and mechanical penthouse.
- The existing District 4 office was constructed 69 years ago, is currently only 24,500 sq. ft., and does not meet modern building codes, including accessibility. A building study showed that more space is required to serve the district's current and future needs.
- Preliminary study investigated renovation vs. new construction options and concluded that new construction
  was preferred because the existing building would require significant upgrades to meet current building and
  energy codes. In addition to expanding the size of the building for staff needs, this would require addressing
  seismic/structural needs, accessibility, fire sprinklers, energy and HVAC system deficiencies. Furthermore,
  renovation would require relocating staff to an alternate location during construction. For these reasons a
  new building is considered a better value.
- The proposed office will be a Zero Net Energy building which will meet or exceed Executive Order No. 594 "Leading By Example: Decarbonizing and Minimizing Environmental Impacts of State Government" and meet the new "Stretch Energy Code". The project will seek Passive House Certification and use on-site renewables including solar photovoltaics (PV) arrays on the roof, sunshades and in solar canopies over the parking area.
- Construction will require the phased demolition of the existing concrete-framed building, The 2-story and 1story wings are to remain operational while the new building is constructed. The existing cell tower will remain intact and operational during construction. Parking and landscape on the north, east, south, and west sides of the site will be modified as part of the project.

- The building will also provide a state-of-the-practice Materials Lab on the 1st floor including a concrete curing room designed with a system for constant misting.
- Vertical circulation is via a 4-stop elevator, two rated egress stairs, and a monumental open stair.

#### **PROCUREMENT:**

On September 28, 2024, the Highway Division advertised the contract for bids. Filed Sub-Bids were opened on December 10,2024 and on January 14, 2025, the Highway Division opened bids for this contract and four (4) bids were received. Cranshaw Construction of New England LP was the lowest qualified and eligible bidder with a price of \$37,613,024.00. The bids were reviewed by engineers in the Construction and Construction Contracts Sections. The Highway Division has accepted the bid submitted by Cranshaw Construction of New England LP, which at \$37,613,024.00 is 14% lower than the Office Estimate of \$43,818,728.00. Disadvantaged Business Enterprise ("DBE") participation is required. The DBE requirement for this Project is 10%. MassDOT's Office for Diversity and Civil Rights has reviewed the DBE information included in the Proposal of the chosen bidder and recommends award of the contract to this contractor.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT/BUDGET SOURCE:

This action is funded through 100% Non-Federal Aid Funds (NFA/SS)

#### FUTURE ANTICIPATED AUTHORIZATIONS:

Prior to the issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy for the new building approximately \$1,300,000.00 will be required for purchase and delivery of furniture and cubicles.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors authorize the Secretary, or her designee, to award and execute MassDOT Contract No. 128297 entitled ARLINGTON- CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW DISTRICT FOUR ADMINISTRATION BUILDING ON APPLETON STREET, with Cranshaw Construction of New England LP in a form approved by the General Counsel, in the amount of \$37,613,024.00.
