**DECISION**

**MYSTIC WINE SHOPPE, LLC D/B/A MYSTIC WINE SHOPPE

Mystic Wine Shoppe, LLC d/b/a Mystic Wine Shoppe (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Quinn's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Quinn's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
3. Copy of New License Approval, 8/17/2012.

**FACTS**


1. On Wednesday, July 24, 2019, at approximately 5:43 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Quinn ("Investigators") conducted an investigation of the business operation of Mystic Wine Shoppe, LLC d/b/a Mystic Wine Shoppe.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 25-ounce can of Bud Light beer, for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2012 with no prior violations.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
