Request for Interpretation Relative to 527 CMR 12.00, NEC 250.140(A)&(B)

Question 1: When an existing one and two-family dwelling units electrical service is replaced in accordance with article 230.85, the neutral and grounding conductors are separated in the panel. Does the existing 2-wire cable that feeds the clothes dryers, cooktop, wall oven, and range also need to be replaced to comply with article 250.140(A)&(B).
