Background:

Request for Interpretation Relative to 527 CMR 12.00, 682.10.

Question #1: Does this Board agree that Article 682 shall apply to the ocean, recognizing it as a natural body of water?

Question # 2: In Article 682.5(3) concerning land areas subject to flooding, shall these land areas be areas designated as flood communities by FEMA?

Question # 3: Shall the local authority having jurisdiction supersede this Board?

- 7. Shall the local authority having jurisdiction waive the requirement of Article 682.5(3) and 682.10 for additions or modifications? (Rule 3)
- **8.** Shall Article 682.10 apply to residential and commercial buildings that are renovating or altering space within a non-conforming existing structure?
- **9.** Shall a GFCI breaker be used to protect electrical equipment and allow for the installation of electrical equipment (per Article 682.10) below the electrical datum plane?
