## DECISION

THE WRIGHT PLACE PUB, INC. 3 CENTRAL STREET ASHBURNHAM, MA 01430 LICENSE#: 003400015

VIOLATION DATE: 02/20/2014

The Wright Place Pub, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 24, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Investigator Bailey's Investigative Report dated February 20, 2014.
- A. Licensee's ServSafe Certificates for All 7 Employees

## **FACTS**

- 1. On Thursday, February 20, 2014 at approximately 7:15 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of The Wright Place Pub, Inc.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased a Budweiser Light beer for two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

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## **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) — Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 — Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
