Vicesrus, Inc. dba Clocktown Package Store (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 23, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
2. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 30, 2013;
3. Can of Coors Light Beer; and
4. Photo of Underage Operative.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS


1. On Tuesday, April 30, 2013, at approximately 5:42 p.m., Investigators Temple and Keefe conducted an investigation of the business operation of Vicesrus, Inc. dba Clocktown Package Store.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a can of Coors Light beer, for one dollar and eighty cents (\$1.80). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for over ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
