REQUESTING A SECURITY (CREDIT) FREEZE

A security freeze is one step you can take to help prevent access to your personal credit report to open new credit accounts, with certain exceptions.

Security freezes are federally regulated, and a security freeze must be temporarily lifted or permanently removed each time you apply for new credit. You may place a security freeze by letter, telephone or on line. To learn more about how to place, temporarily lift, or permanently remove a security freeze on your credit reports please contact the credit reporting agencies below.

If you chose to use a letter it must contain the following information:

- Your full name, address, Social Security number, and date of birth;
- Addresses where you lived over the previous five years;
- Proof of current address such as a utility or phone bill;
- A photocopy of a government issued identification card;
- If you are an identity theft victim, include a copy of the police report, investigative report, or complaint;
