I am writing to you with important information about a recent breach of your personal information by Garlock Printing and Converting. Our investigation into this breach revealed the following:

DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT INCLUDING:

- On Friday June 10, 2022, an email was sent to Robert Rivers and Shawn Gionet containing your Personal Information. This was brought to our attention on June 16, 2022
- The unsecured personal information involved in the breach was, name, address, and social security number.
- We have notified the Massachusetts Office of Consumer Affairs and Business Regulation and the Office of Attorney General. IT has deleted access to the breach email and removed access to that data in our reporting set up.
- Because of the nature of the information breach, we suggest you place a fraud alert on your credit files to protect yourself from the possibility of identity theft. To initiate a fraud alert, you will need to call any one of the three credit bureaus (Equifax, Experian or TransUnion). The credit bureau you choose must tell the other two bureaus to place a fraud alert on your credit report. In addition to the credit reporting that is provided by the credit bureaus in response to the fraud alert, we are offering you a year of free coverage in our MetLegal plan. MetLegal provides credit monitoring and identity management services, as well as assisting with identity theft defense should that become a need. See the attached flyer for more details.

Please note a fraud alert should not prevent you from using your existing credit cards. Once you receive your credit report, review it carefully to verify that all information (name, address, Social Security number, etc.) is correct and there are no accounts you did not open. Monitor your credit reports for several months. An initial fraud alert is valid for 90 days.

Garlock Printing is very sorry for any stress and concern this breach may cause you and your family. We respect the private nature of your personal information and always strive to protect it from authorized or unnecessary disclosure.

We are continuing to review our processes and procedures and will take steps to develop safeguards to prevent such events from recurring.

To accept or waive the offer of Met Life Legal, you must notify Tammy Olson in Human Resources within 90 days from receipt of this letter.


