WHAT IS ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY (AT)?

✓ ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY DEVICES

- AN ITEM, EQUIPMENT, OR SYSTEM USED TO MAINTAIN OR IMPROVE THE FUNCTIONAL CAPABILITIES OF INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

✓ ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

- ASSISTS AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A DISABILITY WITH SELECTING OR USING DEVICES.



HOW DOES A PERSON KNOW WHAT AT THEY COULD USE?

• IDENTIFIES

- PERSONAL GOALS
- BARRIERS: PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, COGNITIVE, ETC
- AREAS THEY WOULD LIKE TO BE MORE INDEPENDENT OR NEED LESS CAREGIVER HELP
