DECISION

STAN'S LIQUOR MART, INC.
1586 SOUTH MAIN STREET
ATHOL, MA 01331

Stan's Liquor Mart, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 12, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Temple's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigator Temple's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 6, 2013.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.


FACTS

1. On Monday, May 6, 2013, at approximately 7:28 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Temple conducted an investigation of the business operation of Stan's Liquor Mart, Inc.
2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) can of Budweiser Light beer for two dollars and twenty cents (\$2.20). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for twenty-four (24) years and has had no violations since 1999, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
