1. Introduction

Welcome to Atlant Moving, your trusted household goods transportation service provider. This Tariff Document outlines our rates, services, and the rules and regulations that govern our operations within the Commonwealth. By utilizing our services, you agree to comply with the terms and conditions set forth herein.

2. Definitions

- Shipper: The person or entity contracting Atlant Moving for transportation services.
- Carrier: Atlant Moving.
- Household Goods: Personal property used for personal, family, or household purposes.
- Bill of Lading: A written contract of carriage between the Shipper and Carrier.
- DPU: The Department of Public Utilities of the Commonwealth of [State].

3. General Rules and Regulations

- A. Compliance with Laws: Atlant Moving operates in accordance with all federal, state, and local regulations and laws.
- B. Non-Discrimination: Atlant Moving does not discriminate against any Shipper on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, or disability.
- C. Accessibility: Atlant Moving ensures accessibility for individuals with disabilities and complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- D. Insurance: Atlant Moving maintains adequate insurance coverage to protect Shipper's goods during transportation. Details are available upon request.

4. Rates and Charges

- a. Published Rates: Atlant Moving's published rates are available upon request and are subject to change. Rates include transportation, labor, and equipment.
- b. Additional Charges: Additional charges may apply for services such as packing, unpacking, storage, and specialized items. These charges will be disclosed before service.
- c. Fuel Surcharge: A fuel surcharge may apply based on fluctuating fuel costs. Shipper will be informed of the surcharge at the time of booking.

Rates

Standard (all days during calendar year, except days listed in "Sub-Peak", "Peak", "Hi- Peak" sections below):

- 2 movers + truck - \$110 (per hour)
- 3 movers + truck - \$145 (per hour)

- Additional mover - \$35 (per hour)
- Additional truck - \$35 (per hour)

Sub-peak (all Saturdays and Sundays from May to September 15th, if it's not under "Peak" and "Hi-Peak" policy):

- 2 movers + truck- \$120 (per hour)
- 3 movers + truck - \$155 (per hour)
- Additional mover - \$40 (per hour)
- Additional truck – \$40 (per hour)

Peak (last two and first two days of the month (from April 29 to September 2nd):

- 2 movers + truck- \$130 (per hour)
- 3 movers + truck - \$165 (per hour)
- Additional mover - \$45 (per hour)
- Additional truck – \$45 (per hour)

Hi-Peak (all official Massachusetts Holidays):

- 2 movers + truck - \$140 (per hour)
- 3 movers + truck - \$175 (per hour)
- Additional mover - \$45 (per hour)
- Additional truck - \$45 (per hour)

- ◇ Medium Box (3.0 cu. ft.): \$5.00 per box

Specialty Boxes:

- ◇ Wardrobe Box (with metal bar): \$30.00 per box
- ◇ Picture/Mirror Box (various sizes): Starting at \$7.00 per box

- ◇ Packing Tape (per roll): \$4.00
- ◇ Packing Paper (per bundle): \$17.00
- ◇ Bubble Wrap (per roll): \$15.00

- ◇ Piano Fee: \$200 (per item per flight)
- ◇ Grand Piano Fee: \$300 (per item per flight)
- ◇ Extra Heavy Item Fee (> 280lbs): \$160

6. Claims and Liability

- i. Liability Limitations: Atlant Moving's liability for loss or damage to household goods is governed by federal and state regulations. Shipper may request additional valuation coverage.
- ii. Filing a Claim: In the event of loss or damage, Shipper must file a written claim within 30 days after the date of service completion.

7. Payment Terms

- i. Payment Due: Payment is due upon completion of services, unless other arrangements are made in advance.
- ii. Accepted Payment Methods: Atlant Moving accepts cash, checks, and major credit cards.

8. Cancellation and Rescheduling

- i. Cancellation: Cancellations must be made at least 48 hours in advance. Cancellations made within 48 hours may be subject to a fee.

- ii. Rescheduling: Rescheduling requests are subject to availability and must be made at least 48 hours in advance.

9. Customer Responsibilities

- i. Packing: Properly pack and label items to be transported.
- ii. Access: Ensure clear access to the pickup and delivery locations, provide permit and designated spot at the pickup and drop off locations
- iii. Documentation: Provide accurate and complete information on the Bill of Lading and other required documents.
