On February 28, 2002, the Cable Television Division ("Cable Division") of the Department of Telecommunications and Energy issued a rate order concerning AT&T Broadband's ("AT&T Broadband" or "the Company") basic service tier ("BST") programming and equipment rates for the above-referenced communities. AT&T Broadband, CTV 01-1/01-3 (2002) ("Order"). In the Order, the Cable Division concluded that on most of the FCC Form 1240s the Company had filed to establish BST programming rates, AT&T Broadband had improperly reported its true-up on Line H14. Id. at 6-10. We ordered AT&T Broadband to revise its BST maximum permitted rates ("MPR") on Line I9 to reflect only the true-up that was actually passed through to subscribers on Line I10, and to report the unused true-up on Line H15. Id. at 10-12. On March 15, 2002, AT&T Broadband submitted its compliance filing for review, consisting of a nine-page document listing the revised calculations. On March 21, 2002, the Company filed revised FCC Form 1240s, Page 4, for all communities except Dover, Erving, Holliston, and Montague, whose BST MPRs were approved in the Order, and nine other communities: Blackstone, Franklin, Gill, Greenfield, Harwich, Millis, Nantucket, Plainville and Waltham. In these nine communities, AT&T Broadband claimed that no adjustments were necessary, because no excess true-up was included in the BST rates.

II. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on our review, we determine that AT&T Broadband's adjustments to Lines H14, H15 and I9 on its revised FCC Form 1240s are reasonable and appropriate. Therefore, we find the BST MPRs calculated on the revised FCC Form 1240s are just and reasonable and in compliance with applicable law. We further find that in Blackstone, Franklin, Gill, Greenfield, Harwich, Millis, Nantucket, Plainville and Waltham, no adjustments are necessary; accordingly, AT&T Broadband's proposed BST MPRs are just and reasonable and in compliance with applicable law.

Upon due notice, hearing and consideration, the Cable Division hereby accepts as reasonable and in compliance with applicable statutes and regulations, AT&T Broadband's FCC Form 1240s as filed on March 1, 2001 for Blackstone, Franklin, Gill, Greenfield, Millis, Nantucket and Plainville.
