Please refer to page 8, lines 17-18 of the Oyefusi/Nurse Testimony which states: "These CLEC access rates have been unconstrained by either competitive retail market conditions or regulation."

- a. Please provide all support for this statement. A complete response will include all quantitative and qualitative analyses reviewed or performed by Dr. Oyefusi or Mr. Nurse to support this statement.
- b. Please define the term "unconstrained" as it is used on page 8.
- c. Please identify the "competitive retail market conditions" that, according to the above quote, are lacking with regard to CLEC access rates and that, if present, would constrain CLEC access rates.
- d. Is this testimony meant to suggest that CLECs do not face competition in the telecommunications retail markets in which they operate? Please explain. A complete response will identify all retail markets in which CLECs operate and in which they do not, in AT&T's estimation, face competition.
- e. If the answer to subpart (d) above is yes, please identify all barriers that exist that prevents AT&T from providing competition to the CLECs in retail markets.
- f. Please admit or deny the following statement: "No regulation whatsoever applies to CLEC intrastate switched access rates in Massachusetts." Unless the answer is anything other than unequivocal "admit," please identify the regulation(s) that do(es) apply to CLEC intrastate switched access rates in Massachusetts.
- g. Please admit or deny whether or not CLEC access rates must be filed with the Department in an approved tariff.
- h. Please admit or deny whether or not any CLEC access tariff filing has been rejected by the Department within the last two (2) years. If any has been rejected, please provide full details.
- i. Please admit or deny that CLECs are classified as non-dominant carriers in Massachusetts. If the answer is anything other than an unequivocal "admit," please explain.

RESPONSE:

- a. See Exhibit A to CLEC-ATT 1-15(a), . See also response to DTC-ATT 1-1, 1-2.
- b. The context within which the word "unconstrained" is used is explained at Page 8, lines 13-18. *See also* Page 9 Page 12 for our explanation why market forces cannot constrain CLEC rates.
- c. See (b) above
- d. This statement is not meant to suggest that retail markets are not competitive. On the contrary, it states that the competitive conditions that discipline rates in retail markets do not exist for switched access and, thus, do no constrain rates charged by Massachusetts CLECs in the switched access market.
- e. N/A. See (d) above.
- f. In the referenced statement, we emphasize that CLECs in Massachusetts have regulatory flexibility. The Department has presumed that the market will discipline CLEC retail prices sufficiently to meet the statutory requirement of "reasonableness" without further regulation. Because this presumption does not apply to the switched access market, CLECs are able to set their intrastate access rates at any level they choose.
- g. Where switched access service is offered on a common carriage basis it must be tariffed.
- h. The information requested is a matter of public record and AT&T has no obligation to conduct research of the public record for other parties in this case.

This request calls for a legal opinion. The nature and extent of the Department's classifications, as well as any exceptions thereto are a matter of law to be briefed, not a matter of fact to be admitted or denied.

MODIFIED RESPONSE:

See Modified Exhibit A to CLEC-1-15(a), which is modified to include a CCL charge for Choice One that was inadvertently omitted from the initial filing. It also includes a statement of the blending assumptions that were used but were not displayed on the initial filing. See also response to DTC-ATT 1-1, 1-2.

Please refer to page 13, lines 6-8 of the Oyefusi/Nurse Testimony where it states that "when a CLEC increases its originating access rates in Massachusetts, it pressures IXCs like AT&T to raise toll rates in Massachusetts for *all* of its long distance customers to recover the additional costs."

- a. Please provide a list of all intrastate toll rate increases that AT&T has implemented in Massachusetts for the past five year time period.
- b. Please identify the CLEC rate increases in Massachusetts, if any, that resulted in AT&T raising its toll rates in Massachusetts.
- c. Please provide a list of all intrastate toll rate increases of other IXCs that have raised their intrastate toll rates in Massachusetts in the past five year time period. Please identify the CLEC rate increases, if any, that caused such IXC rate increases.
- d. Please provide by month and year AT&T's toll revenues for Massachusetts for the previous five year time period.

RESPONSE:

The quoted sentence was intended to mean that AT&T's current toll rates for all its long distance customers are logically higher than what they otherwise would have been if its access rates were lower. As a result, whether there were in fact actual toll rate increases is irrelevant. Moreover, in a competitive market, price increases and decreases are not always or even often evidenced by increases or decreases in tariffed rates. In fact, in a highly competitive market, such as the interexchange market, carriers offer a variety of different plans and bundles. Carriers are just as, if not more, likely to effectuate price increases or decreases through the offering of new plans or packages, or to modify their marketing practices for existing plans and packages, as they are through the simple increase or decrease of a single tariffed rate. If, for example, a carrier provides an incentive for a customer to switch to a lower priced plan, the carrier's average revenue per minute will decline, even though the carrier has not changed any of

its tariffed prices for its services. Any tariffed rate increases implemented by AT&T are a matter of pubic record and can be obtained from the Department.

- b. See response to DTC-ATT 1-3.
- c. This request seeks information (such as tariffed rate increases of third party carriers) that is equally available to the CLECs as to AT&T. To the extent that it seeks information regarding effective price increases caused by different plans or bundles, AT&T does not know. AT&T also does not have any information regarding which CLEC rates increases may have caused which IXC rate increases.
- d. AT&T is currently compiling the necessary information to respond to this request and will provide as soon as possible.

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE:

d. See Confidential Exhibit A to CLEC-ATT 1-20(d) attached hereto. AT&T does not have the information by month. Providing it in such form would require a burdensome study. The attached exhibit shows the requested information by year, with the following clarifications. The numbers in the attached show AT&T's *switched* toll revenues. Revenues from toll services carried on special access circuits are not relevant to this proceeding. The attached data also do not include TCG data as those data are *de minimus*.

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE NO. 2:

d. During the hearings, AT&T witnesses Nurse and Oyefusi expressed uncertainty regarding the accuracy of the numbers contained on Confidential Exhibit A to CLEC-ATT 1-20(d). They have since investigated and obtained confirmation that the numbers are correct and hereby swear to their belief in their accuracy.

Refer to your testimony on page 16, line 5. Provide all documents and information relied on in making the determination that traffic pumping is taking place in Massachusetts. Where applicable, provide details of any specific instance of traffic pumping in Massachusetts that AT&T is aware of.

RESPONSE:

Over the past two years, AT&T has observed a significant increase in schemes designed to artificially stimulate terminating access traffic to certain high cost local exchange carriers around the country. In November 2007, the FCC issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, specifically designed to address this practice. AT&T, along with a number of other interested parties, filed Comments on December 17, 2008, Reply Comments on January 16, 2008, and an ex parte filing on February 21, 2008. See Exhibits A, B and C to DTC-ATT 1-5. These comments describe in detail several 'traffic pumping' schemes, as well as AT&T's recommendations to for rule changes to stop the practice.

In Massachusetts as well, AT&T has observed evidence of such "traffic pumping." As part of AT&T's regular processes, access service invoices from local exchange carriers are reviewed for accuracy. This review identifies invoices that reflect inordinately large volumes of terminating access minutes of use. One of the criteria for determining unusual traffic volumes is a comparison of the average terminating MOUs per working telephone number. Recently AT&T identified a Massachusetts CLEC that appeared to be engage in 'traffic pumping' activity resulting in extraordinary large access billing to AT&T. Attached to this response are two charts that AT&T relied on in determining that the CLEC was engaged in activity that resulted in suspicious volumes of terminating traffic. See Exhibit D to DTC-ATT 1-5. The first chart provides a

comparison of the average terminating MOUs per working TN for all CLECs currently billing AT&T for terminating access services in excess of one million MOUs per month in Massachusetts. As shown by the highlighted entry, the CLEC in question is billing AT&T sixteen (16) times more terminating minutes than the average of the other CLECs included in this analysis. Once the CLEC was identified based on the abnormal activity, AT&T investigated the nature of the numbers to which the abnormally high call volume was terminated. AT&T did this by actually calling the telephone numbers and by searching for the numbers in Google. The results of that effort are shown in the second chart. As indicated there, the called number frequently is a "chat room" or platform for other services.

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE:

At the hearings, in connection with questioning regarding trafficpumping, Mr. Chattopadhyay reminded the parties of their continuing duty to update responses with new information that becomes available. Tr. 9/24/08, at pp. 339-340. As a result, AT&T witnesses Nurse and Oyefusi have reviewed AT&T's on-going investigations into suspicious activities including traffic-pumping. Mr. Nurse and Dr. Oyefusi learned that AT&T maintains a database of telephone numbers that have been identified over time as "chat-lines". The method of identifying chat-lines is not automated; it is labor intensive and is not designed to be comprehensive. It is typically done on a case-by-case basis. If a representative in AT&T's fraud unit by chance encounters a chat-line as part of a routine investigation of unusual traffic patterns, the representative is supposed to check the chat-line database to determine if the number is already present and, if not, to forward the number to AT&T's fraud desk, where it is supposed to be added to the database. The database must be checked periodically to determine whether numbers once identified as chat-lines have been reassigned to other endusers.

There are 242 Massachusetts telephone numbers presently in AT&T's chat-line database. The telephone numbers in the chat-line database are the telephone numbers of end-users of two or more CLECs operating in Massachusetts. Attached to this response is a report of the top 17 telephone numbers (chat-lines), based on total intrastate minutes of use during September, 2008. Terminating intrastate toll minutes of use for

these 17 numbers are shown on Exhibit E to DTC-ATT 1-5. These 17 numbers represent approximately 277,000intrastate minutes of chat-line termination in Massachusetts during September for AT&T alone. Because of this level of termination, some of these individual telephone lines can be extremely profitable for a CLEC. For example, the first telephone number listed had over 60,000 intrastate terminating minutes from AT&T alone during the month of September. The local exchange carrier of this customer therefore (whose terminating access rates are in the \$0.04 range) earned more than \$2,400 from AT&T terminating traffic. If AT&T's percentage of the terminating traffic is 25%, the CLEC is earning almost \$10,000 in a single month from access on this customer. With these revenues, it would not be difficult to price the retail rate at or below zero. Below zero of course means that the CLEC would be sharing the access revenues with the end user. It is important to note that these telephone numbers have been manually identified by chance as a result of investigations that may have been prompted by other events entirely. They represent an unknown fraction of all the chat lines operating in Massachusetts.

Part of AT&T's investigation of chat-line numbers involves an internet search. The greeting message when the number is called often provides a website or uses distinctive words that permit a related website to be found using an internet search engine. Attached to this response as Exhibit F to DTC-ATT 1-5 is a copy of several different websites associated with many of the Massachusetts numbers in the AT&T chatline database. (All of the attached websites are associated with numbers in the chat-line database for Massachusetts, but one or two may not be associated with the telephone numbers included in the top 17 identified in Exhibit E.) This does not purport to be a comprehensive display of websites associated with Massachusetts chat-line numbers because – as we stated above - the numbers used as the basis for obtaining these websites were discovered by chance as chat-lines. We cannot rule out the possibility that there are many more Massachusetts chat-lines with associated websites. When CLECs earn four cents or more for each terminating minute of a call placed to these chat-lines, we believe that there is a significant amount of "extra" money that can be shared with the operators of the chat-line.
