Subject: Billing of Intrastate Access Charges on Access Toll Connecting Trunk Switched Access Dedicated Tandem Trunk Ports This notice is to inform you that the Verizon Operating Telephone Companies have identified instances of under-billing of intrastate Access charges on Switched Access dedicated tandem trunk ports associated with charges on Switched Access dedicated tandem trunk ports associated with Access Toll Connecting Trunks. The applicable dedicated tandem trunk port intrastate Access charges were not billed properly because the PLUR factor was applied in Verizon's Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) to dedicated tandem trunk ports associated with Access Toll Connecting Trunks, trunks which would not be carrying traffic subject to the PLUR factor. This under-billing affected service provided by Verizon Operating Telephone Companies \* in the states of MA, ME, NJ, NY, PA, VA, VT and WV. As a result, for your Access Toll Connecting Trunks, the dedicated tandem trunk ports will be excluded from the PLUR factoring process and, based on the applicable PIUR factor, will be billed the applicable dedicated tandem trunk port intrastate Access charges using the P4TNX USOC, which will be added to your billing account(s) on July 20, 2007. On your first bill following this date, Verizon will correct the billing on a going forward basis by adding the P4TNX USOC to your Access Toll Connecting Trunks. Verizon reserves the right to back-bill the applicable dedicated tandem trunk port intrastate Access charges for the affected ports. Subject: Back Billing of Intrastate Access Charges on Access Toll Connecting Trunk Switched Access Dedicated Tandem Trunk Ports This notice is to inform you that the Verizon Operating Telephone Companies have identified instances of under-billing of intrastate access charges on switched access dedicated tandem trunk ports associated with Access Toll Connecting Trunks. The applicable dedicated tandem trunk port intrastate access charges were not billed properly because the PLUR factor was applied in Verizon's Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) to dedicated tandem trunk ports associated with Access Toll Connecting Trunks, trunks which would not be carrying traffic subject to the PLUR factor. This under-billing affected service provided by Verizon Operating Telephone Companies1 in the states of MA, ME, NJ, NY, PA, VA, VT and WV.

As a result, on your September, 2007 bill, Verizon will back bill the applicable intrastate access charges for the affected dedicated tandem trunk ports. Back billing of charges will extend back to the more recent of the Service Establishment Date for the affected port or two years (24 months). The adjustments will be identified in the "Other Charges and Credits" portion of the invoice using a PON of "CLECATCS754."
