**MEMORANDUM AND ORDER ON LICENSEE'S  
REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION**

**DEPINAS PLACE INC. D/B/A PLEASANT STREET BAR & GRILL

Depinas Place Inc. d/b/a Pleasant Street Bar & Grill (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "ABCC" or "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, March 9, 2021, regarding alleged violations of:

- 1) 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Mass. Exec. COVID- 19 Order No. 55 (Nov. 2, 2020) – Patron or employee failing to wear a mask or cloth face covering over their mouth and nose when in a public location;
- 2) 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the Licensed Premises, to wit: Violation of Mass. Exec. COVID-19 Order No. 57 (Dec. 8, 2020).

By decision dated March 25, 2021, the Commission found the Licensee in violation of the charges and indefinitely suspended the License effective forthwith until further written order from this Commission.

The Commission stated that it would consider issuing a further order upon written request of the Licensee showing good cause to reconsider this indefinite suspension. Good cause for the Commission would include, but not be limited to, the Licensee's receiving approval from the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") as to a reopening plan.

On March 29, 2021, the Licensee submitted a written request to reconsider the indefinite suspension. On April 2, 2021, the Commission received the notice of approval from Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards ("DLS").

**CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence presented, the Commission reconsiders and reverses its prior order of **INDEFINITE SUSPENSION** of the license of Depinas Place Inc. d/b/a Pleasant Street Bar & Grill effective forthwith.
