

MINUTES

August 25, 2025

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on August 25, 2025. In participation was: Supt.

Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, and Commissioners James Quirk and Emily Beebe.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:
Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is Meeting remotely pursuant to legislative authorization extending the remote meeting provisions of the Open Meeting Law through June 30, 2027, as signed into law by Governor Healey on March 28, 2025.

Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to approve the minutes of July 28, 2025. Commissioner Quirk 2nd the motion and it passed by way of roll call.

Cape Cod National Seashore issued a limited area permit for larviciding. We have since found breeding outside of the permitted treatment zone and hope to get those sites included in next year's permit request.

Supt. Sakolsky updated the Board on surveillance findings so far. There have been 279 WNV positive mosquito samples collected around the Commonwealth with 6 coming from Barnstable County. Risk levels in Barnstable, Mashpee, Falmouth and Sandwich were elevated to moderate.

Recent storm surges pushes water into the marshes around Cape but with otherwise dry weather the crews were able to keep up with checking and treating before any salt species emerged.

Supt. Sakolsky informed the Board that she was waiting to learn the date of the next SRB meeting at which they will appoint a Commissioner who applied and interviewed for an open position on the CCMCP Board.

The next meeting was scheduled for September 29, 2025 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Commissioner Quirk and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
