

MINUTES

August 28, 2023

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on August 28, 2023. In participation was: Supt. Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Supt. Barton Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, and Commissioners Jim Quirk and Emily Beebe.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:

'Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is meeting remotely in accordance with G.L. Chapter 30A, §§ 18-25, and pursuant to Chapter 20 of the Acts of 2021, An Act Relative to Extending Certain COVID-19 Measures Adopted During the State of Emergency, signed into law on June 16, 2021, as extended by Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023.'

Commissioner Quirk moved to approve the minutes of July 31, 2023. Vice-Chairman Collins 2nd the motion and minutes were approved unanimously by way of roll call.


Supt. Sakolsky notified the Board that the project plans to move forward with applying for the electric vehicle charging station grant this week, utilizing the Commonwealth procurement platform CommBuys.

Supt. Sakolsky informed the Board of pesticide resistance testing being conducted by The Northeast Regional Center for Excellence in Vector-Borne Diseases. We will share results once obtained.

Current field conditions were discussed and surveillance data was shared. Trucks ordered in November 2021 are now ready for pickup.

The next meeting was scheduled for September 18, 2023 at 3:00 PM.

There being no further business, Commissioner Quirk moved to adjourn, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
