

MINUTES

August 29, 2022

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on August 29, 2022. In participation was: Superintendent Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Bart Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, Secretary Arthur Neill, and Commissioners Jim Quirk and Emily Beebe.

Chairman Milne read the following remote meeting declaration:

'We are meeting remotely in accordance with An Act Relative to Extending Certain State of Emergency Accommodations ("Act"), which was signed by Governor Baker on July 16, 2022. This Act extends the expiration of certain provisions pertaining to the Open Meeting Law to March 31, 2023, allowing a public body to continue holding meetings remotely without a quorum physically present at a meeting location as long as it provides "adequate, alternative" access to remote meeting.'

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to approve the minutes of July 25, 2022. Motion 2nd by Commissioner Beebe and approved by way of roll call, with Secretary Neill abstaining due to being absent from that meeting.

Commissioner Beebe made a motion to appoint Jim Quirk as Assistant Secretary for the purpose of signing meeting minutes, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call with Commissioner Quirk abstaining.

The Commissioners discussed the current Collins Center for Public Management most recent scope of services for the proposed study.

Superintendent Sakolsky updated the Board on arbovirus testing, field conditions, new-hire statuses and long-term leave statuses.

The next meeting was scheduled for September 19, 2022 at 2PM. There being no further business, Commissioner Quirk moved to adjourn, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
