Highlights:

- Potential for two rounds of heavy rainfall this week with possible flooding:
- Thunderstorms Wednesday with I-2" of rain on average
- Debby's remnants could bring widespread heavy rainfall Friday into Sunday with another 2-3"+







Outlook: Sat Aug 10 - Wed Aug 14

Odds favor above average rainfall and below average temperatures

Higher chance of above average temperatures







- July rainfall was below average in much of eastern MA • Near to above normal elsewhere including the Islands and most of Cape Cod
- Three-month departures have shown a decline in northeast MA and six-month departures are now on the lower end of the normal range in that region
- For the first few days of August, rainfall has been minimal on the South Coast, Cape Cod, and the Islands but near to above normal elsewhere
- Two rounds of heavy rainfall possible this week • Debby's remnants could bring widespread 2-3"+ Friday-Sunday
- Above normal temperatures should continue through the summer and fall • A period of below average temperatures is possible this month
- Odds favor above normal rainfall through the rest of summer and fall Watching the tropics for additional activity
