
## July Precipitation & Departures


#### Precipitation

Accumulated Precipitation (inches) July 01, 2025 to July 31, 2025


### Departure from Normal

- 1-2" inch totals north of I-90
- 2-4" inches south of I-90 and eastern MA
- 1-3" inches southeast MA, Cape, and Islands

Wide range in departures (-3" to + 3")


## 3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal



## Last 3 Months (May-Jul)

- Near or above normal for most of MA
- Near to below normal for Cape/Islands (60-100%, 40-60% for Nantucket)


Precipitation Percent of Normal February 01, 2025 to July 31, 2025



#### Last 6 Months (Feb-Jul)

- Mostly near-above normal (100-140%)
- Outer Cape/MVY: 60-100%
- Nantucket 40-60%

Precipitation Percent of Normal May 01, 2025 to July 31, 2025




## 7 Day Precipitation Forecast

- No precipitation forecast east of Worcester County
- 0.01 to 0.25 inches forecast for Worcester County and west

10 Day High End/Low End Forecast Precipitation Amounts


- 100 Forecast Models
- ~90 predict 10 Day QPF > 0-0.1"




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- 100 Forecast Models
- $\sim 10$  predict 10 Day QPF > 0.75-1.5"






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
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## Outlook: August 10<sup>th</sup> - August 14th



### Odds favor near-normal precipitation and above normal temperatures






## Outlook: August 16<sup>th</sup>-August 29<sup>th</sup>




Equal Chances for Above or Below Normal Precip Above Normal Temperatures Likely




## Outlook for Aug, Sep, Oct

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
## Latest River Forecasts

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No river flooding anticipated during the next ten days.

- A 52 member ensemble run for all NERFC forecast points to give us an idea of the possible range of river flows out 10 days.
- No Flooding Forecast



#### July:

- Departures ranging from -3 to +3 inches below/above normal
- Below Normal Precipitation for most of Massachusetts
- Pockets of above normal precipitation in eastern/central MA

#### Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month and 6-month departures near or above normal for most of the state
- Sections of Cape and Islands still below normal (40-80% of normal)

#### Outlook:

- 7 Day Outlook is very dry with only 0.01-0.25" of precipitation forecast for the western half of the state
- No strong signal for above or below normal precipitation in the long range forecast (beyond 10 days)
