DECISION

CARLIN'S REST, INC. **7 DEPOT SQUARE AYER, MA 01432** LICENSE#: 006000002 HEARD: 10/4/2011

Carlin's Rest, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 4, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

FACTS

- 1. On, August 29, 2011 at approximately 7:01 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Carlin's Rest Inc.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Bud bottle for four dollars and zero cents (\$4.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
