After a hearing on March 2, 2016, the Commission finds Page-Moore Cafe, Inc. d/b/a Billiards Café violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale and delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count).

Therefore the Commission suspends the license for a period of three (3) days of which one (1) day will be served, and two (2) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.

The suspension shall commence on Wednesday, April 20, 2016 and terminate on Wednesday, April 20, 2016. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, April 20, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Thursday, April 21, 2016.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

Page-Moore Cafe, Inc. d/b/a Billiards Café (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, March 2, 2016, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale and delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Keefe's Investigative Report dated December 11, 2015; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

- 1. On Friday, December 11, 2015, at approximately 10:30 p.m., Investigators Velez and Keefe ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Page-Moore Cafe, Inc. d/b/a Billiards Café to determine the manner in which their business was being conducted.
- 2. Investigators entered the licensed premises and observed a youthful appearing male who approached the bar and ordered a bottle of Bud Light beer.
- 3. Investigators observed that the bartender on duty, Nolan Boissoneau, did not ask the Underage male for identification before serving him the beer.
- 4. Investigators identified themselves to the youthful appearing male and asked to see proof of age.

- 5. The underage male presented to Investigators his Massachusetts driver's license listing his actual date of birth 07/03/1995 (age 20).
- 6. Investigators informed the owner, Calvin Moore, of the violation and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further review.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale and delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count). Therefore the Commission suspends the license for a period of three (3) days of which one (1) day will be served, and two (2) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
