

MASSACHUSETTS BOARD OF BAR EXAMINERS
BAR EXAM SECURITY POLICY

STRICTLY ENFORCED

All violations will be reported to the Board of Bar Examiners and may impact eligibility for admission to the Massachusetts bar.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones brought to the exam site must be powered down, placed in a *Yondr Case* (www.veryondr.com) and held at the examinee seat for the entire testing day. The *Yondr Case* will only be unlocked by bar exam staff at the conclusion of the testing day.

TESTING RULES

Examinees are prohibited from:

- Writing, typing, erasing, or otherwise altering an examination answer once time is called. No exceptions will be made.
- Looking at or copying another examinee's test materials.
- Removing or attempting to remove any test materials from the examination room.
- Having bar review or other materials at the exam site at any time.
- Attempting, by any method, to share or exchange exam information.
- Giving or receiving assistance to or from any examinee.
- Talking while the examination is in session.
- Being disruptive to the bar examination process by any sound or movement, either inside or outside the exam room.
- Being verbally or physically abusive to anyone, including examinees, security, or exam personnel.
- Falsifying or misrepresenting exam or personal information.

EXAMINEES USING A LAPTOP

While in exam rooms, examinees are prohibited from:

- Accessing programs and platforms, with the exception of EXAMPLIFY.
- Connecting to the internet, email, notes or study materials.
- Opening any and all programs, windows and documents.
- **Computers must be left in the examination room during the lunch break.**

Please be advised that any unattended items, including, but not limited to, coats, bags, and prohibited items found at the exam site will be confiscated and subject to search and disposal by the Board of Bar Examiners.

Testing Area - rooms, hallways and other spaces reserved by the BBE for the administration of the bar exam.

Exam Room - rooms where testing takes place.
