In accordance with M.G.L. c. 111, §§ 5, 20, and 21, as well as Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) Regulations 105 CMR 451.000: Minimum Health and Sanitation Standards and Inspection Procedures for Correctional Facilities; 105 CMR 480.000: Storage and Disposal of Infectious or Physically Dangerous Medical or Biological Waste (State Sanitary Code, Chapter VIII); 105 CMR 590.000: Minimum Sanitation Standards for Food Establishments (State Sanitary Code Chapter X); the 2013 Food Code; 105 CMR 500.000 Good Manufacturing Practices for Food; and 105 CMR 205.000 Minimum Standards Governing Medical Records and the Conduct of Physical Examinations in Correctional Facilities; the Department's Community Sanitation Program (CSP) conducted an inspection of the Barnstable County Correctional Facility on April 24, 2019 accompanied by Lieutenant Ken Shaffer. Observations and Recommendations

- 1. The inmate population was 316 at the time of inspection.
- 2. At the time of inspection:
 - a. The Department recommended that all showers be identified with a numbering system. This will assist the Department and correctional employees to better recognize where issues exist; and
 - b. There were no inmates housed in Pod D because it was closed. The Department observed all cells to be double-bunked and the potential for overcrowded cells exists if inmates were to be housed in this Pod at a later date.

This facility does not comply with the Department's Regulations cited above. In accordance with 105 CMR 451.404, please submit a plan of correction within 10 working days of receipt of this notice, indicating the specific corrective steps to be taken, a timetable for such steps, and the date by which correction will be achieved. The plan should be signed by the Superintendent or Administrator and submitted to my attention, at the address listed above.
