# **Observations and Recommendations**

- 1. The inmate population was 326 at the time of inspection.
- 2. At the time of inspection, the Department recommended that all showers be identified with a numbering system. This will assist the Department and correctional employees to better recognize where issues exist.

In accordance with 105 CMR 451.404, please submit a plan of correction within 10 working days of receipt of this notice, indicating the specific corrective steps to be taken, a timetable for such steps, and the date by which correction will be achieved.
