DECISION

SJR Group, Inc. dba 586 Bistro & Bar ("The Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c.138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("The Commission") held a hearing on September 28, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 4.03. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On, June 26, 2010 at approximately 12:02 a.m., Commission Investigators Jamie Binienda, Mark Kenny, and Chief Mahoney investigated the business operation of SJR Group, Inc. dba 586 Bistro & Bar.

2. The Investigators identified themselves to the doorman on duty. The doorman refused entry of the premises until the Investigators showed their personal identification.

3. The Investigators observed a bartender, identified as Michael Walker, on two occasions deliver more than two drinks to one person.

4. Chief Mahoney observed Mr. Walker deliver three alcoholic beverages to a male patron and the male patron walked out of Mr. Walker's visibility to the other side of the bar.

5. Investigator Binienda also observed Mr. Walker deliver six alcoholic beverages to two female patrons who walked out of Mr. Walker's line of vision to the dance floor.

6. Mr. Walker did not attempt to see where the drinks were going to on either occasion.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 4.03. The Commission issues a **WARNING.**
