#### **DECISION**

YASHVASIN CORP. D/B/A CRAIGVILLE PACKAGE STORE 2946 FALMOUTH ROAD BARNSTABLE, MA 02601 LICENSE#: 90564-PK-0070

Yashvasin Corp. d/b/a Craigville Package Store ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, October 1, 2024, regarding alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Gould's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Gould's Violation Report;
- 2. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Transfer of License Approved 7/19/2023;
- 3. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Thursday, June 27, 2024, at approximately 8:00 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Gould ("Investigators") made observations of Yashvasin Corp. d/b/a Craigville Package Store ("Licensee" or "Craigville").
- 2. At approximately 8:20 p.m., while outside of the licensed premises, Investigators observed a youthful appearing male individual enter the establishment and minutes later, exited in possession of alcoholic beverages, a 30-pack of Busch Light beer.
- 3. Investigators identified themselves to the individual and asked to see proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.
- 4. Underage #1, actual date of birth 5/03/2005 (age 19), provided to Investigators a fraudulent Ohio driver's license bearing his name but a different birth date. Investigators confiscated the alcoholic beverages.

- 5. Investigators entered the licensed premises and spoke with an employee, informed her of the violation and that a violation report would be submitted to the Chief Investigator for further review.
- 6. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2023.

### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count). As a result, the Commission issues a **ONE** (1) **DAY SUSPENSION which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years** provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.
