#### **DECISION**

ISHANA, INC. D/B/A QUABBIN PLAZA LIQUORS 578 SUMMER STREET BARRE MA 01005 LICENSE#: 89149-PK-0072

VIOLATION DATE: 4/1/2019 HEARING DATE: 6/11/2019

Ishana, Inc. d/b/a Quabbin Plaza Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 11, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) — Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 — Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Binienda's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report;
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 3. Licensee's Application Summary Review.

# **FACTS**

- 1. On Monday, April 1, 2019, at approximately 4:35 p.m., Investigators Velez and Binienda ("Investigators") investigated the business of Ishana, Inc. d/b/a Quabbin Plaza Liquors.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Bud Light beer, for seven dollars and forty-nine cents (\$7.49). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
