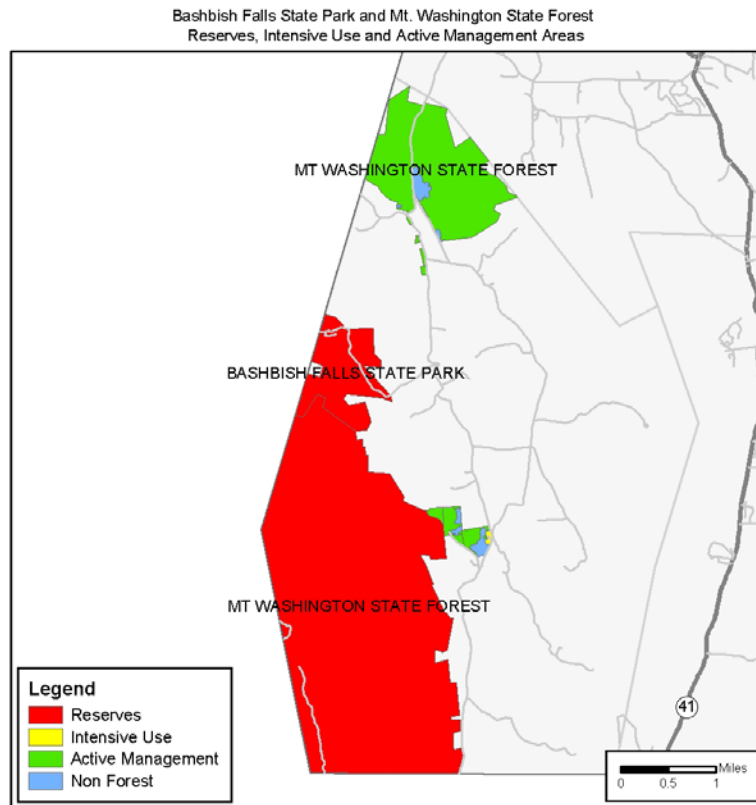

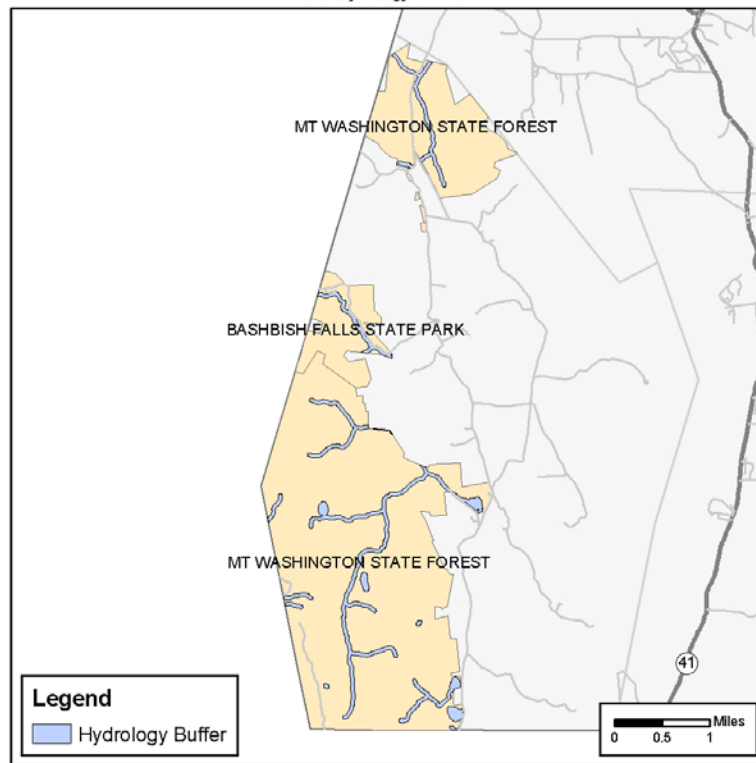

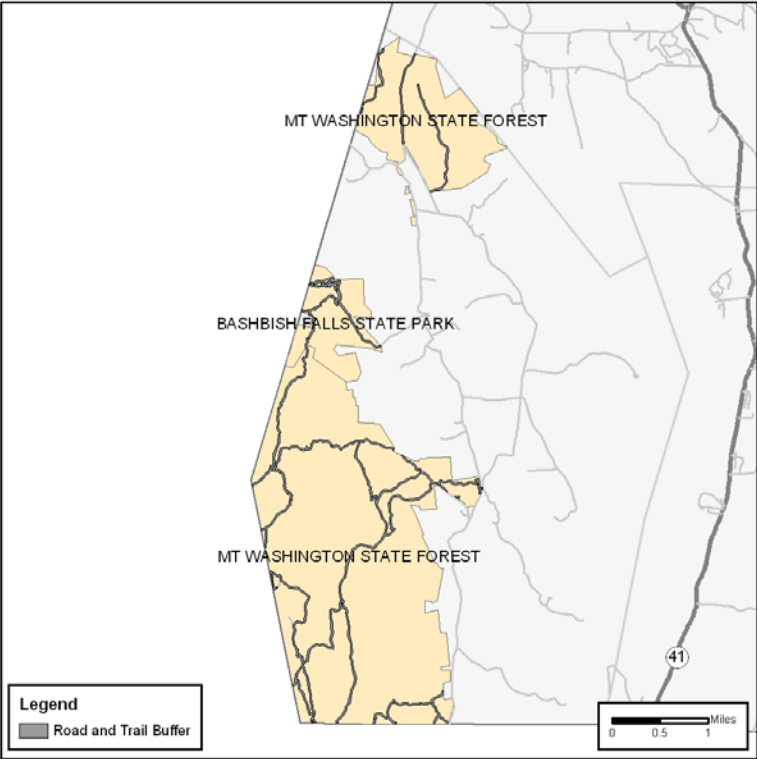

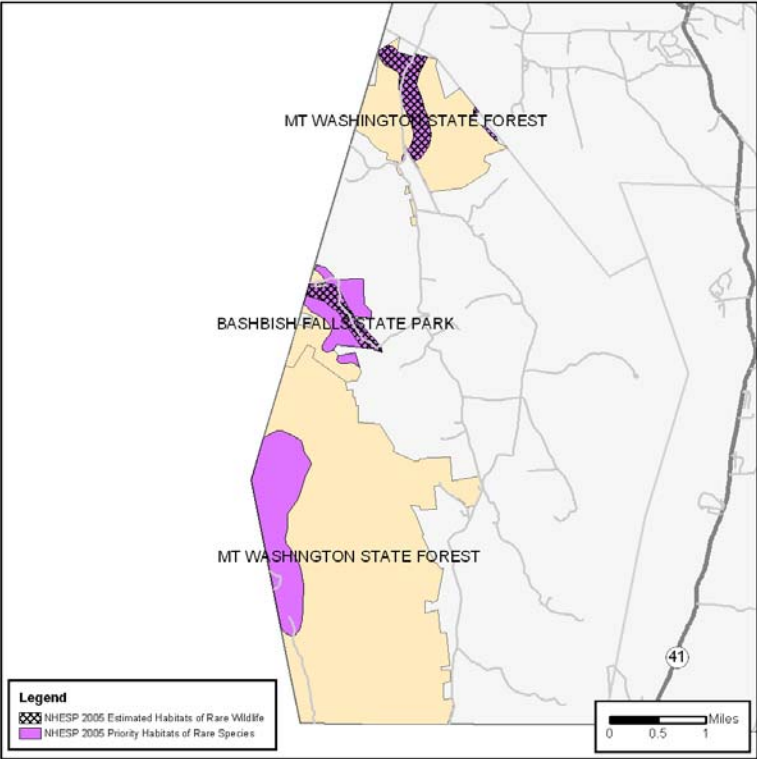
Bash Bish Falls State Park and Mt. Washington State Forest  
100' Hydrology Buffers



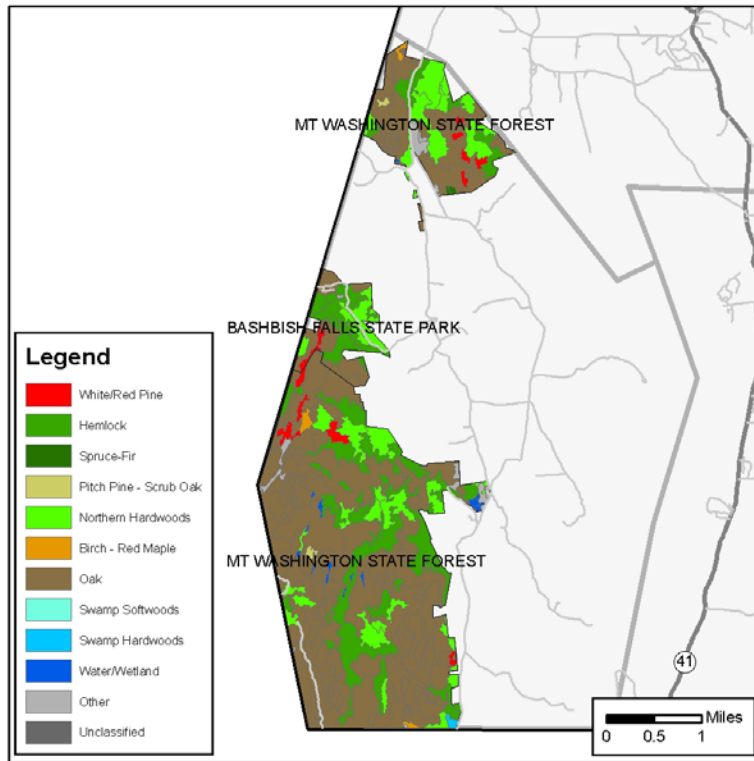

50' Road and Trail Buffers



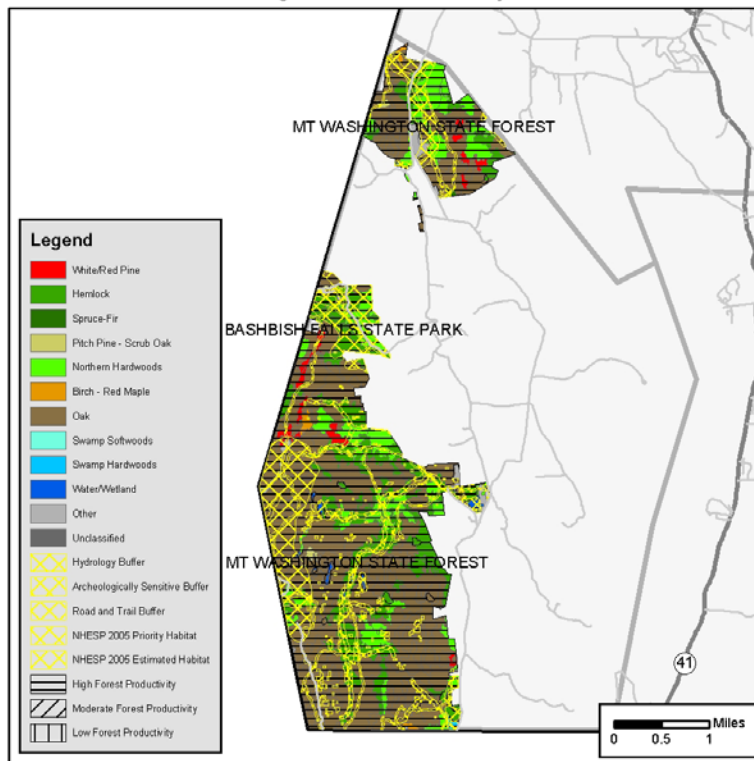

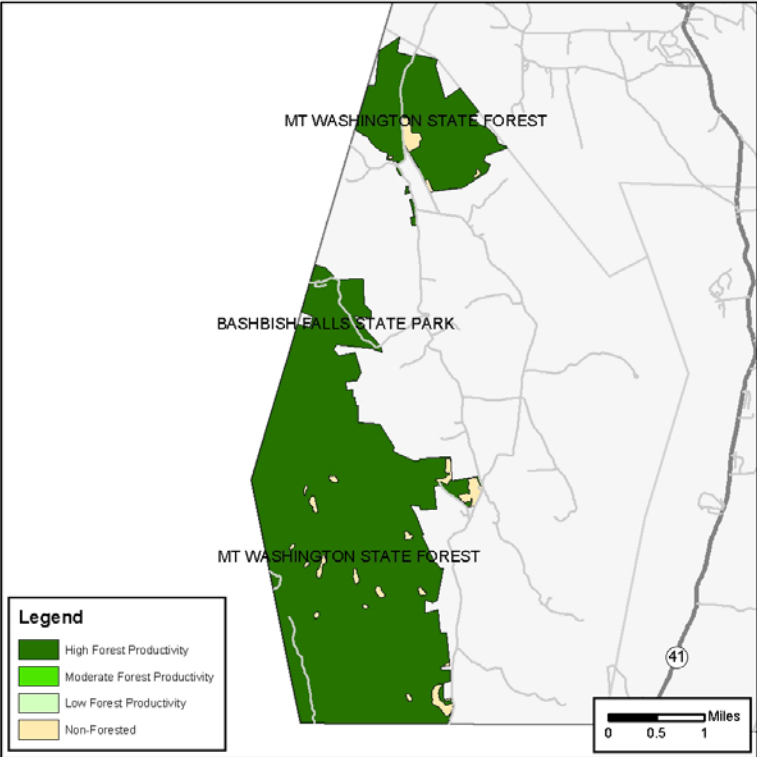
