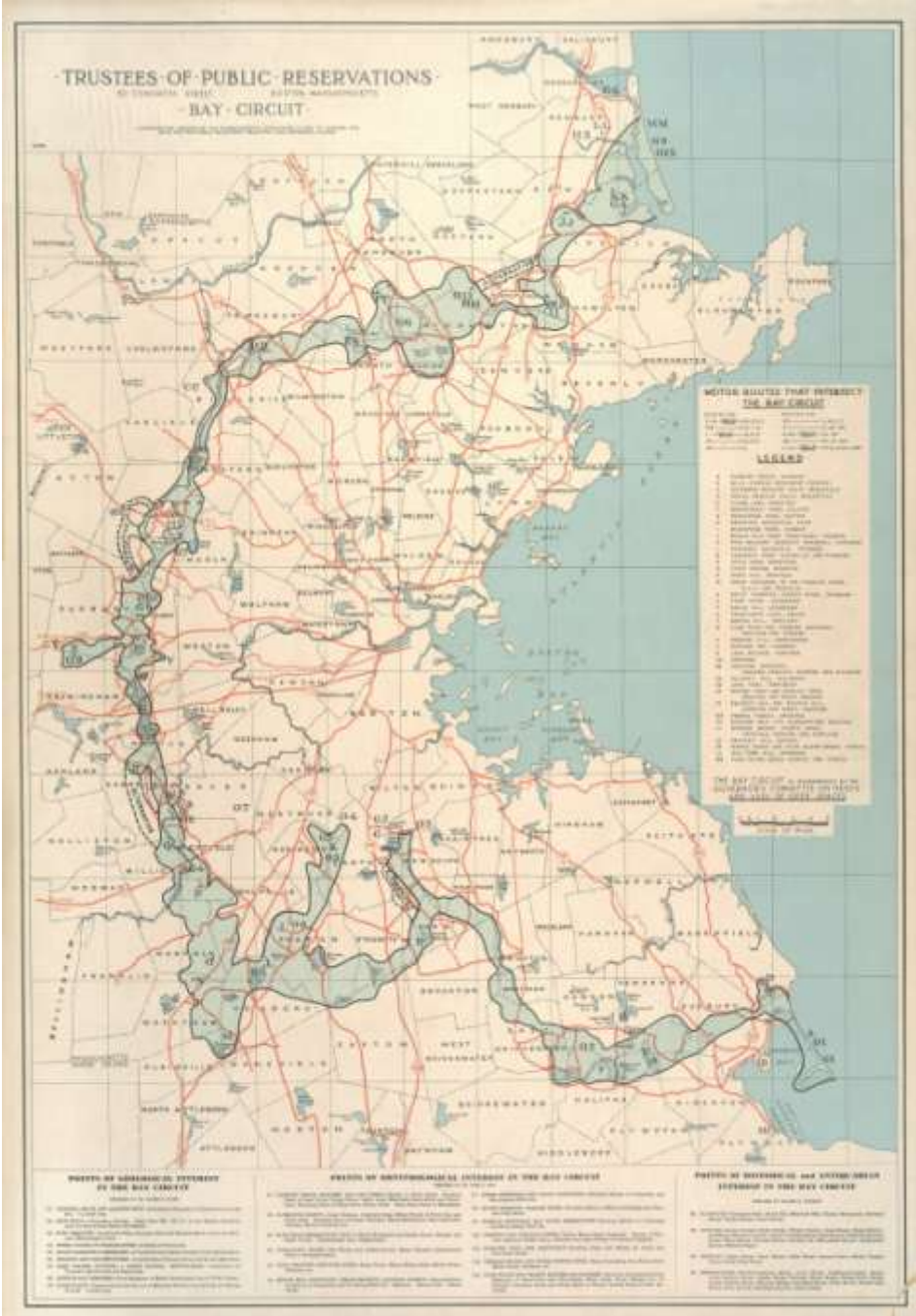

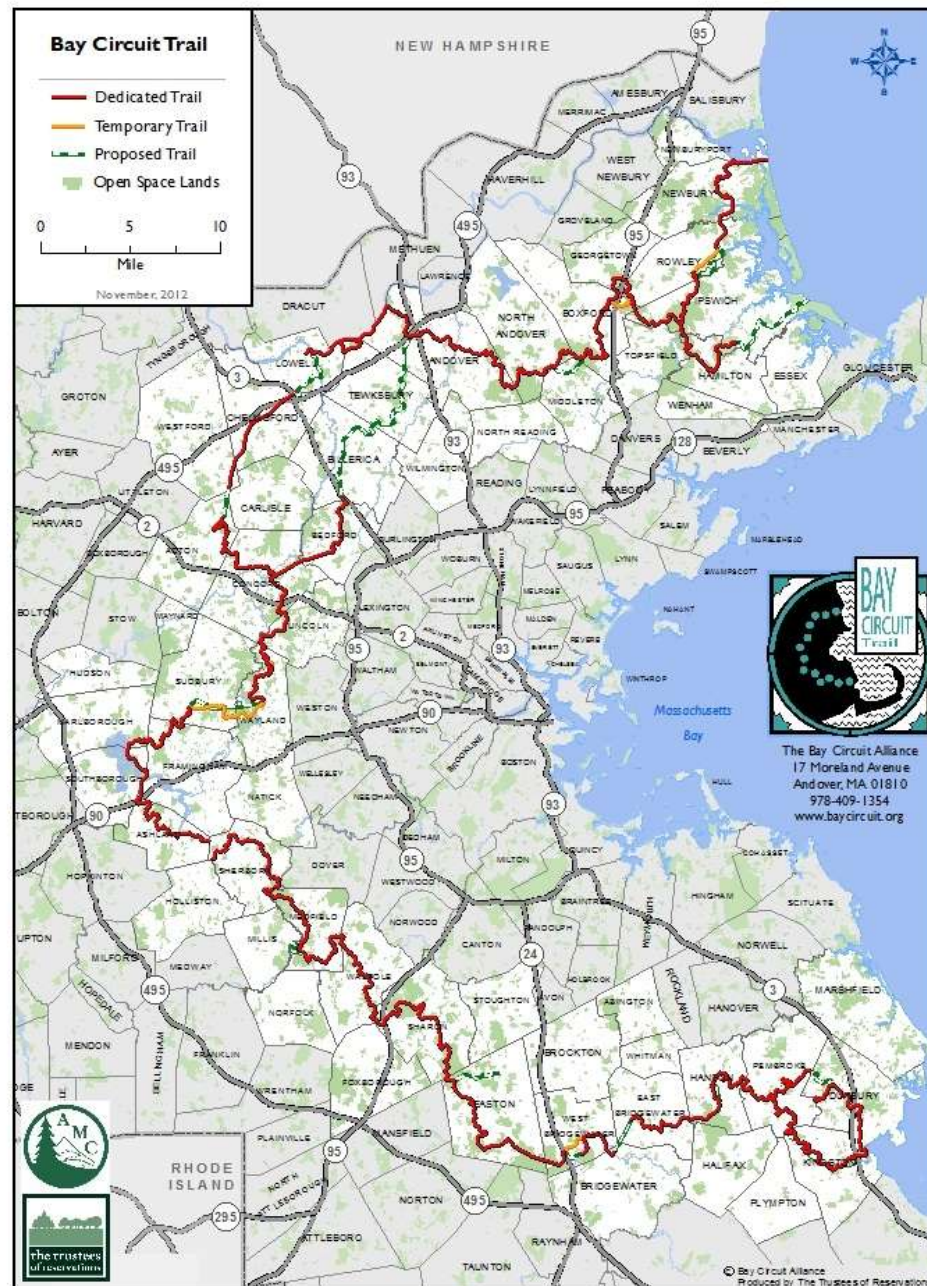

# Bay Circuit Trail and Greenway Highlights



- 200 mile trail that weaves through thousands of acres of conservation land and adjacent trail networks
- 184 miles accessible to the public; 90% complete
- Offers close to home outdoor experiences to 4+ million people living in Greater Boston
- Provides short or full-day trips for people of all ages and abilities
- Over 50 communities surrounding Boston are connected by the trail and greenway, with easy access from Portsmouth, Worcester, and Providence

# Bay Circuit Alliance

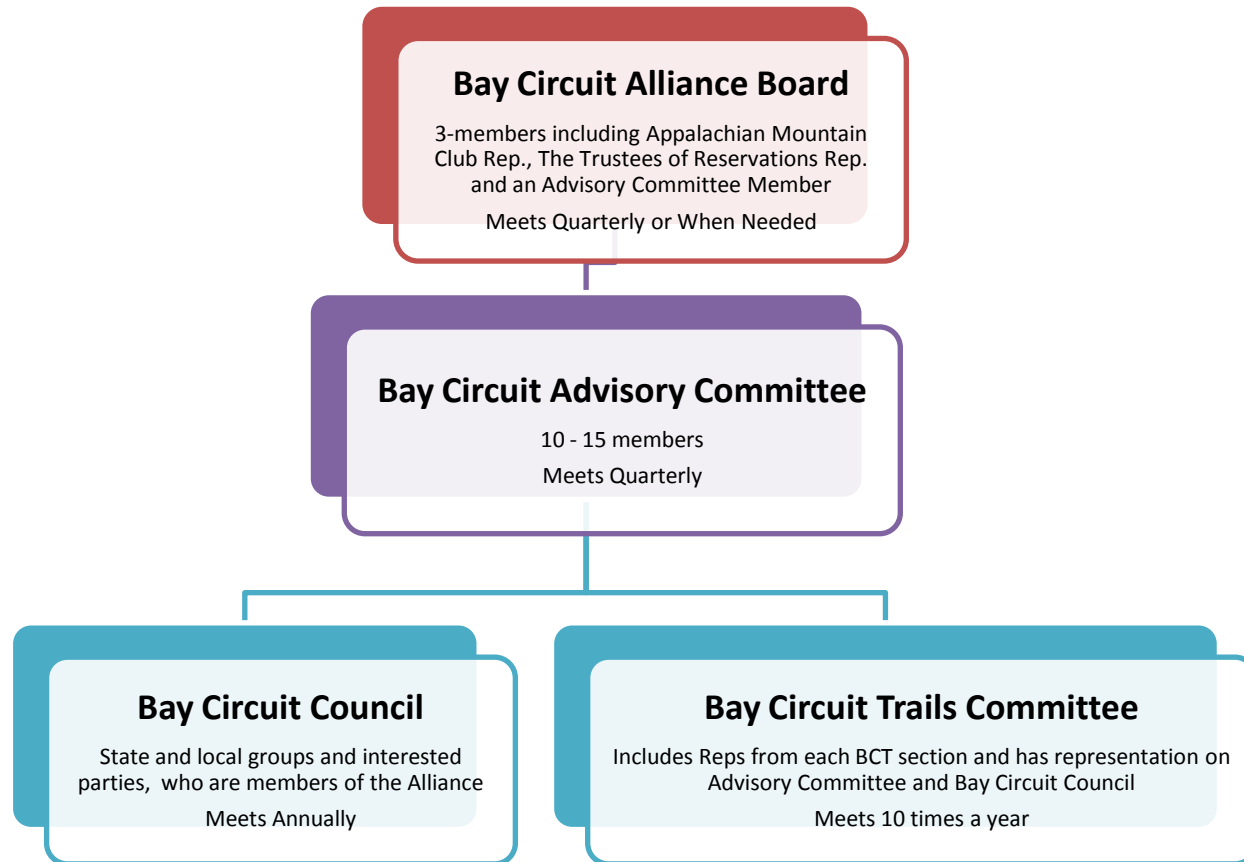


Founded in 1990.

Now has over 40 member including non-profits, towns and individuals.

In March 2012 by-laws were approved for new leadership of the Bay Circuit Alliance.

*The AMC and Trustees are collaborating to lead the Bay Circuit Alliance in the completion, enhancement, and long-term care of the 200-mile Bay Circuit Trail and Greenway.*



# 2013 Projects

- AMC is currently conducting a *Trails Inventory and Assessment* to be completed in the Fall of 2013.
- Providing trail trainings with AMC, The Trustees and REI to recruit new volunteers for the trail.
- Closing the remaining gaps in the trail!
- Developing a *Landowner and Trail Protection* database for lands the trails traverses.
- Creation of 5 years goals for the Bay Circuit Alliance.
- Updating the Bay Circuit Alliance website and adding new features.
