DESCRIPTION OF ORGANIZATION

11. Briefly describe your organization.

Baystate Wing Hospital Corporation (BWH) is a Massachusetts not for profit community hospital, the sole member of which is Baystate Health, Inc., the not for profit, charitable 501(c)(3) parent of an integrated health care delivery system primarily serving Western Massachusetts. BWH was founded in 1913 and is located in Palmer, Massachusetts. The hospital provides a broad range of emergency, medical, surgical, home health, hospice and psychiatric services to residents of Palmer, Ware, Monson, Wilbraham, Ludlow, Belchertown and other nearby towns. BWH has 74 licensed beds, including 42 medical/surgical and ICU beds, 4 pediatric beds and 28 psychiatric beds, and approximately 72 active medical staff providers and 776 employees. BWH is fully accredited by The Joint Commission, it is qualified as a Disproportionate Share Hospital, and it is designated a Primary Stroke Service Center by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health.

BWH has entered into an Agreement of Merger with Baystate Mary Lane Hospital Corporation (BMLH), a not for profit community hospital, pursuant to which BWH and BMLH have agreed to merge BMLH with and into BWH. Under the terms of the proposed transaction, BWH will be the surviving entity and will be operated under a single hospital license. Following consummation of the transaction, all inpatient medical and surgical care and most observation care will be provided at BWH. Satellite emergency services, outpatient surgical procedures, chemotherapy and other cancer care, laboratory services, imaging and limited observation care will continue to be provided at the BMLH facilities, which will

Satellite emergency services, outpatient surgical procedures, chemotherapy and other cancer care, laboratory services, imaging and limited observation care will continue to be provided at the BMLH facilities, which will become a satellite location under BWH's hospital license. There will be no exchange of funds between the parties with respect to the proposed transaction and no changes in Health Care Services, as defined in 958 CMR 7.02, are anticipated.
- Briefly describe the anticipated impact of the proposed Material Change, including but not limited to any anticipated impact on reimbursement rates, care referral patterns, access to needed services, and/or quality of care:

 It is anticipated that the proposed transaction will enhance access to high-quality, cost-effective care in the communities jointly served by BWH and BMLH. BWH and BMLH, which together comprise the Baystate Health Eastern Region, are located less than 10 miles away from each other. The inpatient average daily census at BMLH is currently low, and with 74 inpatient beds, BWH currently has more than sufficient capacity to care for the patients who are now hospitalized at BMLH. It is anticipated that concentrating inpatient hospital care in one higher-volume facility with more critical-care resources and capabilities will provide the community with increased access to higher-quality care. The anticipated increased census at BWH will also enable BWH to attract more specialists to the area. The proposed transaction will reduce duplication and improve efficiency of care delivery, and thereby help to manage health care costs and enhance long-term viability of health care delivery in the region. The merger will also help to ensure that the most appropriate care is delivered in the most appropriate settings and that the communities served by BWH and BMLH continue to have access to high-quality care. Other than the consolidation of inpatient medical and surgical care and most observational care at BWH, it is not anticipated that the proposed transaction will impact reimbursement rates.

BWH and BMLH believe that the proposed transaction is subject to the "single entity" doctrine in antitrust and is exempt from any requirements of the Hart-Scott-Rodino Act.
