Regular Meeting Portion

- BBRS Minutes. On a MOTION by Jen Hoyt, seconded by Michael McDowell, it was unanimously VOTED by ROLL CALL to approve the minutes for the November 9, 2021, Board of Building and Regulations and Standards (BBRS) meeting as amended (EXHIBIT B). The amendments included Ian Finlayson making the motion, Jen Hoyt redrafted the 1st sentence in the second paragraph, and added the last sentence under agenda item six (6). Jen Hoyt also struck "related to NFPA 241 should be referenced in 780 CMR" in the last paragraph of agenda item six (6).
- 2. **BCAB Minutes**. On a **MOTION** by Kerry Dietz, seconded by Michael McDowell, it was unanimously **VOTED** by **ROLL CALL** to approve October 19, 2021, and November 2, 2021, Building Code Appeals Board (BCAB) minutes as submitted (**EXHIBIT C**).

- 3. **BOCC Minutes.** On a **MOTION** by Kerry Dietz, seconded by Michael McDowell, it was unanimously voted to approve the minutes for the November 2, 2021, Building Official Certification Committee (BOCC) meeting as submitted (**EXHIBIT D**).
- 4. **Discuss****Vote** Board meeting dates and locations for the calendar year 2022. On a **MOTION** by Kerry Dietz and seconded by Lisa Davey, it was a unanimous vote to approve the BBRS Meeting Dates 2022 (**EXHIBIT D**).
- 5. **Discuss** updated Draft 10th Edition Schedule. The schedule allows the board to see the 10th edition progress (**EXHIBIT E**). The revised schedule reflects the Technical Advisory Committees and Study Groups that reviewing various chapters of the I-Codes will be providing their report to the Board soon. Should the Board have the codes in March 2021, this would allow holding a public hearing in April or May. No action was taken.
- 6. Review/Vote Existing Buildings Technical Advisory Committee report on the 2021 IBC Chapter 34, IEBC recommendations (EXHIBIT F). Mike DiMascio reviewed Chapter 1 through Chapter 10. Jen Hoyt expressed interest in providing edits to the Committee's work. Mike DiMascio explained Section 307 has new amendments that clarify when the 50% trigger updating detection is part of the work. He also explained that the Committee discussed removing Section 306 Accessibility because accessibility requirements come from 521 CMR in Massachusetts. In the end, the Committee relied on Section 101.2 Scope that guides users of the IEBC to consider Chapter 1 in the IBC, which directs the code users to 521 CMR for accessibility requirements. Mike DiMascio talked about the Committee trying to make as few changes to the IEBC as possible, which is the direction given to the Committee. The Board discussed Massachusetts has some general laws that require amending some provisions of the I-Codes. Some Board members spoke about the Governor directing all code writing boards to adopt national codes and amending the I-Codes beyond what is needed to conform to a General Law is inconsistent with the Executive Branch's direction. Due to the time, Mike DiMascio ended discussion of a new amendment that strikes exception two (2) in Section 1011.1.2.1, so the code users will not be directed to the IRC.
- 7. **Discuss** 93 new Construction Supervisor Licenses (CSLs) issued in the month of November 2021. Board members acknowledged the number of newly issued CSLs.
- 8. The Board discussed having more of the IBC and IRC chapters as soon as practical, so each Board member can review ahead of the meetings so that the chapters can be voted and made available for the public to become more familiar with the proposed 10th edition.
- 9. Quasijudicial Session. On a MOTION by John Couture, seconded by Michael McDowell, it was unanimously VOTED by ROLL CALL to close the public meeting @ approximately 12:20 p.m. to enter quasijudicial Session for the issuance of a final decision in an adjudicatory matter per M.G.L. c. 30A, §21. The Board voted to adopt the recommendations of the Hearing Officer and issue a Final Decision and Order in Case Record 117-00193.
- 10. Investigative Conference. On a MOTION by Michael McDowell, seconded by John Couture, it was unanimously VOTED by ROLL CALL @ approximately 1:31 p.m.to exit quasijudicial session and move into closed investigative conference prior to the issuance of an order to show cause pursuant to M.G.L. c. 112, §65C. During closed investigative conference, the Board referred a complaint against DL for unlicensed practice as a Construction Supervisor to prosecutions.
- 11. Adjourn. On a MOTION by Jen Hoyt, seconded by Michael McDowell, it was unanimously VOTED by ROLL CALL to adjourn the meeting.
