2. Discuss proposed amendments and new content of 2021 IBC, Chapter 18, for inclusion in the Tenth Edition of the Massachusetts Building Code (780 CMR).

Ground Improvement. This meeting was convened to take a final look at proposed Chapter 18 revisions, most particularly ground improvement requirements, prior to submitting to members of the BBRS for review during their February 8th meeting. Committee members indicated that they were satisfied the final draft. However, John Roma reminded members that he would still like to consider factor of safety reduction to 2.25 regarding the dynamic testing of piles. Rob Anderson explained that committee members may continue to offer changes to the proposed code up to and through the public hearing that will be convene towards mid-year.
