Summary of Case: Appellants sought relief from 780 CMR 403, 602, 101 & 780 CMR 503, with respect to

new construction.

Jake Nunnemacher made a MOTION that was SECONDED by Michael McDowell, to render an INTERPRETATION that the Project is not a high-rise building for purposes of 780 CMR thus, the BCAB overturned ISD's Building Code Refusal with respect to ISD's interpretation and application of 780 CMR 403, 602, and Table 503 to the Project, on condition that the Project must follow Code requirements associated with the definition of "Fire Area" in 780 CMR 202. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.
