David Riquinha made a **MOTION** that was **SECONDED** by Kent Vinson, to **AFFIRM** the Building Commissioner's interpretation and application of "as deemed necessary"...for the general safety and welfare of the occupants and the public" authorized by **780 CMR 34.00**, **101.4.2** to the property, which is further supported by what **780 CMR 102.6.4** authorizes. The Motion was approved by unanimous vote.

 Chapter 143 Section 3U, with respect to a new, glazed, shower enclosure in an existing building.

Kent Vinson made a **MOTION** that was **SECONDED** by David Riquinha, to **AFFIRM** the Building Commissioner's determination that **MGL Chapter 143**, **Section 3U** requires permanent labeling of the glazing. The Motion was approved by unanimous vote.

Kent Vinson made a **MOTION** that was **SECONDED** by David Riquinha, to **GRANT** variances from **780 CMR 703.3**, **Exception 3**, to allow for the modified 1-and-2-hour fire rating as requests and from **715.3** to allow the additional fire-stopping as requested, noting that the City's ISD and Fire Department do not oppose the BCAB's allowing the requested relief. The Motion was approved by unanimous vote.
