 Appellants sought relief from 780 CMR Appendix C Tables C102.1 and C102.2, with respect to new construction.

Kerry Dietz made a **MOTION** that was **SECONDED** by Kristen McDonough, to provide an interpretation that, with respect to the Building Commissioner's letter of January 27, 2021, **780 CMR Appendix C Tables C102.1 and C102.2** apply to the Project and allow unlimited size of the building ("Motion One"). Motion One was approved by unanimous vote. Steven Frederickson made a **MOTION** that was **SECONDED** by Kerry Dietz to **ALLOW** the roof snow load calculations and specifications as Appellant proposed based on Appellant's expert engineers' analyses and evidence about proposed systems to address snow accumulations ("Motion Two").
