1. Case Number: 21-0010

Appellant: Joseph Hennessey (Owner-Kems Corp., LLC)
Property Address: 95 Faucett Street, Cambridge, MA. 02138

**Summary of Case:** Appellants sought relief from 780 CMR 1011.7, with respect to new construction.

Kerry Dietz made a **MOTION** that was **SECONDED** by Kristen McDonough, to **GRANT** a variance to **780 CMR 1011.7**, to allow the stairs to be constructed of combustible materials on the first floor and the basement levels.

Summary of Case: Appellants sought relief from 780 CMR 1023.5, 1023.6 (8th Edition), 780 CMR 706.1, and

706.2, with respect to new construction

Jake Nunnemacher made a MOTION that was SECONDED by Kerry Dietz, to GRANT variances to

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780 CMR 1023.5 and 1023.6 (8th Edition of 780 CMR) on conditions that: (1) Appellant follows the details submitted in the Appeal Application (Exhibit 1-B); (2) full smoke detection is installed in areas attached to the corridor; (3) full smoke detection is installed in the exit corridor ("Motion One"). Kerry Dietz made a MOTION that was SECONDED by Jake Nunnemacher, to GRANT variances to 780 CMR 706.1 and 706.2 (8th Editions of 780 CMR) to allow the construction of fire-rated walls as described by the evidence ("Motion Two"). Motion One and Two were both approved by unanimous votes.
