Summary of Case: Appellants sought relief from 780 CMR R105.1, with respect to an existing building.

Jake Nunnemacher made a **MOTION** that was seconded by Steven Frederickson, to **UPHOLD** the Building Official's decision regarding **780 CMR R105.1**, yet also to **GRANT** an allowance for them to keep storage in the Field House as currently stored until no later than September 30, 2020, with the conditions as agreed upon: 1) fire watch being in there every 2 hours, 2) jail house being surveyed by the camera as in the appellant's testimony. 3) No extensions shall be added beyond September 30, 2020.
