Mr. Barile called the meeting to order at 7:01am with Roll Call: Joe Barile, present: Greg Dorrance, present: Christine Fagan, present: Dr. Henry Vaillancourt, present.

Chair Barile noted the new "Act" which extends the expiration of certain provisions pertaining to the Open Meeting Law to March 31, 2023, allowing a public body to continue holding meetings remotely without a quorum physically present at a meeting location as long as it provides "adequate, alternative" access to remote meetings.

MINUTES:

MOTION made by Christine Fagan to accept the minutes of the July 12, 2022 meeting. Seconded: Greg Dorrance. No further discussion, motion passes unanimously via roll call, 4-0.

MOSQUITO UPDATE:

Weekly reports sent to the Commission on mosquito activity was discussed. Bristol County is in severe drought. Discussion ensued about a date to end adulticiding for the season. Low populations and sporadic WNV detections are a factor but rain events can quickly change the season. Commissioners discussed the extension of the season due to climate change and the necessity for a quick response. This topic will be discussed further at the next meeting. BCMCP will be submitting *Culex* mosquitoes for resistance monitoring by NEVBD.
