Superintendent Matton provided an update on spring aerial larvicide plans. Plymouth County's airplane applications to the Hockomock and Bolton Swamp will be conducted. A methoprene application is scheduled to be conducted because of high water levels and substantial *Cs. melanura* numbers from last fall. The *Cq. perturbans* application by helicopter to the cattail marsh in Easton is planned for the spring. Legal newspaper notice and congested flight plan are completed. Further details will be provided as they become available.
