MINUTES:

SRMCB MEETING REVIEW:

An emergency meeting was held Saturday 8/24/2024 to approve the aerial adulticide application in response to EEE activity in Plymouth County. They also approved truck based ULV applications in central MA in conjunction with Clarke in response to EEE activity. The current application map does not include any locations within Bristol County and is scheduled for 8/27/2024.

FIELD AND SURVEILLANCE UPDATE:

In total for the state: 95+ EEE pools, 2 horses and 4 humans and 314+ WNV pools and 10 humans. In response to the aerial adulticide application, BCMCP will provide non-treatment surveillance data. There are no results to date. BCMCP's last adulticide application date is scheduled for 9/13/2024. We will continue to trap until the first frost or populations decrease significantly.
